About the Festival

The Whitsunday Writers Festival was a valued annual event in our region from 2010 to 2017. After the tragic loss of its founder Gloria Burley in 2018, the hardships of TC Debbie, and the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic lockdown to the region, the Festival has not presented a program for seven years.

The restored 2024 Festival will be a national cultural event held in Airlie Beach Queensland, supported by a dedicated national media and marketing campaign to attract around 150+ attendees and sell out events.

The Festival includes:

Love Letter to Queensland is a unique event, the first of its kind in Queensland, and will be staged Thursday 5 September 2024 prior to Festival. It will bring together five notable Queenslanders who will express their love for their state through a love letter read during the event. A community writing competition will also be held, and a curated edited collection to be published.

The inaugural **Whitsundays Literary Heart Awards** captures the passion, depth, and impact of literary works while also paying homage to the captivating Heart Reef —a natural wonder found in the Whitsundays region. In 2024, the Festival will award up to \$10,000 in prizes across four award categories. A publication of select entries is planned for publication.

The main **Whitsundays Writers Festival** program will be held 6 to 8 September 2024. The program will feature international best-selling and award-winning Australian authors and local writers in interactive workshops, panel discussions, and author talks. The program also includes special events - Friday evening Poetry Karaoke, Saturday Big Book Club High Tea, Saturday Sundowner, and the Local Author Long Lunch.

About the Whitsundays

In partnering with the Festival, our sponsors will receive increased exposure to both the local region and visitors from around Australia.

LOCATION: The Whitsundays in north-east Queensland approximately 1,120km north of Brisbane, 630km south of Cairns, 247km south of Townsville, and 150 km north of Mackay.

POPULATION: As of June 2023, the estimated population of the Whitsunday Regional Council area was 39,712.

VISITORS: In 2023, the Whitsundays welcomed 724,000 domestic visitors and 156,000 international tourists.

DIRECT FLIGHTS: Whitsunday Coast Airport (Proserpine) airport has direct flights from Cairns, Sunshine Coast, Brisbane, Coast, Gold Coast, Newcastle, Sydney, Melbourne, and Adelaide. Flights also arrive at Hamilton Island Airport.

WEATHER: It is generally agreed that September is the best time of the year to visit the Whitsundays -- astounding sunny weather, low humidity, and near non-existent rainfall, with an average high of 25°C and average low of 19°C.

CULTURAL EVENTS: The Whitsundays Writers Festival is a welcome addition to the region's cultural festivals including:

- Airlie Beach Music Festival (8,000 participants in 2023)
- Great Barrier Reef Festival (12,500 participants in 2023)
- Whitsundays Arts Festival (9,200 participants in 2022)
- Whitsundays Songwriter Festival (30,000 reached with 88 participants in 2023)

It is a supper club style, and the speakers can use any form of writing to express their love.

Love Letter to Queensland will attract further regional interest with a competition for the community to express their love in their own letter with prizes for the most creative. Winner categories will be adult, secondary school, and primary school students. If the entries are of a suitable standard, a book will be curated and published for distribution.

This event is positioned to bring significant attention to the region and presents an opportunity for an organisation to leverage the concept and message that Queensland holds a significant place in many high-profile lives.

Poetry Prize selected based on its originality, creativity, and expressiveness. First Prize \$1,000 and Runner-Up \$500
