About the Festival

The Whitsunday Writers Festival was a valued annual event in our region from 2010 to 2017. After the tragic loss of its founder Gloria Burley in 2018, the hardships of TC Debbie, and the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic lockdown to the region, the Festival had not presented a program for seven years.

The restored 2024 Festival was a national cultural event held in Airlie Beach Queensland, supported by a dedicated national media and marketing campaign to attract around 150+ attendees and sell out events. The 2025 Festival has taken the best from 2024 and enhanced events to provide an even more wonderful experience for attendees and participants. The marketing campaign will build on the success of the inaugural festival to reach even more populations in the growing sector of cultural tourism.

The Whitsundays Writers Festival program will be held 12 to 14 September 2025. The program will feature international best-selling and award-winning Australian authors and local writers in interactive workshops, panel discussions, and author talks on Saturday and Sunday. The program also includes special events - Friday evening opening Love Letter to Queensland, Saturday evening Poetry Karaoke at Whisper Bar, Saturday Big Book Club High Tea at the Rainbow Cafe, and the Local Author Long Lunch on Sunday at the Whitsunday Sailing Club.

Love Letter to Queensland is a unique event, the first of its kind in Queensland, and will be held as the opening night event in 2025 on Friday 12 September. After the opening ceremony with Festival patron Mayor Ry Collins, Love Letter to Queensland will bring together five notable Queenslanders who will express their love for their state through a love letter read during the event. A community writing competition will also be held and the winning entry read by Mayor Collins.
